Iowa Council of the United Blind 2023 Conference and Convention August 25-26, 2023

Registration

This year's convention is hybrid, so you can choose to attend either in person or via Zoom. In either case, you must pay the registration fee of \$20.00 per person in order to participate in convention business, as well as hear the luncheon performance and banquet speaker. You will be asked on the registration form below which way you have chosen to attend. If you choose to attend by Zoom, we will send you an email--or call if you don't have email--with the Zoom information you need to connect. Convention sessions will also be streamed on ACB Media Radio, but listeners will not be able to participate in convention business or hear the luncheon performance and banquet speaker. Friday night's music at the fire pit by Steve Hagemoser & Band, "Two Tall Guys with Guitars," will not be available via Zoom.

COVID Disclaimer

COVID prevention precautions such as masks and social distancing are not required for convention attendees. The conference area is spacious enough to accommodate any persons preferring distance seating, however.

Hotel Reservations

We are pleased to host our convention again this year at the Courtyard Marriott, 2405 SE Creekview Drive, in Ankeny. The hotel features comfortable rooms with free Internet service, minirefrigerators, microwaves and flat-panel televisions, as well as a fitness room, swimming pool, and hot tub. The Bistro Restaurant, Starbuck's, and a convenience/sundry store are located on-site.

Room rates are \$104.00 a night for a room with either one kingor two queen-size beds. The total with tax is \$116.48 per night. To reserve your room, call Marriott central booking (800-321-2211) or the Ankeny Marriott office (515-422-5555). To get the reduced rate, you must reserve your room no later than August 11. You must let them know you will be attending the ICUB convention to get the reduced rate.

Transportation

Convention Meals

Convention attendees will gather for breakfast on Saturday morning in addition to the usual noon luncheon and evening banquet. The costs are \$18.00 for breakfast, \$22.00 for lunch, and \$40.00 for the banquet. You will need to indicate which meals you will be

attending and your meal choices on the registration form provided at the end of this packet.

Hospitality

Meeting with friends is one of the highlights of attending the ICUB convention. After the first general session on Friday and after the banquet on Saturday, a time for gathering is planned. Food brought in from outside the hotel is NOT permitted outside of your room, but you can bring in beverages and snacks you have purchased from the Bistro Restaurant or Grab and Go area both located in the hotel lobby. Friday night hospitality will be in the Courtyard room (just past the Bistro) and outside by the fire pit (weather permitting). There will be no food or beverage provided for this gathering, but you can bring your own as mentioned above. On Saturday after the banquet, a time to linger and chat will continue in the banquet room. The cash bar will be available, and ICUB will provide some desserts and snacks purchased from the hotel.

Door Prizes and Raffles

Drawings for door prizes will be made during convention sessions and the banquet. To be eligible to win, you must have paid the registration fee and be present in person at the convention. Zoom attendees are not eligible for these prizes. The Des Moines Chapter, however, is giving away a \$100.00 gift card Saturday afternoon to a current ICUB member who is present either in person or via Zoom at the time of the drawing.

Two raffles will be held during the convention, the proceeds of which will go to ICUB. One is a 50/50 raffle, in which the lucky winning ticket holder wins half of the money collected. Tickets are \$1.00 apiece or six for \$5.00. The other raffle is for a \$100.00 Amazon Gift Card. Tickets are \$2.00 each. The winning tickets will be drawn at the banquet, and the winners do not need to be present to win.

Pre-Convention activities

Along with registration on Friday afternoon, we are holding two breakout sessions beginning at 2:00 PM. In the Dancing through Life session, Lisa Davis will provide lessons in ballroom dancing. These lessons are for everyone, and no previous dancing experience is necessary. The Hands-On Art session is an art project lead by Madelyn Mayberry from the Des Moines Art Center and Denise Bean from the Iowa Department for the Blind. They will walk us through creating a make-and-take home art piece. Each session will be offered twice, so you can participate in both if you like. Registration for the break-out sessions will be included on the registration form at the end of this publication.
